- All individuals receiving Employment/ATE services must have a new **Action Plan for People Receiving Employment/ATE Services** included within the ISP at their 2012 ISP Meeting.
- Any change that occurs after this date must use the new **Change form**.
- All other ISP forms and materials (dated 9.9.09) may continue to be used.

# NEW ISP TEMPLATE AVAILABLE


- You can continue to use what was originally published, but be aware that a glitch won't let you change the Meeting Date.

# WATER TEMPERATURE SAFETY

Any water temperature regulation:

1. that in place in response to the OARs,
2. that is there to impact the overall safety of the environment,
3. that is not in place to address the safety needs of a particular person(s),

does NOT qualify as a reason to mark YES to the RTR question about water temperature.
